M.G.L. c. 55 exempts from the definition of political action committee a committee which: (1) has been in existence for at least six months; (2) has contributed to five or more candidates; and (3) only receives contributions from individuals that do not exceed \$161 in any calendar year.

Such committees are to be known as "People's Committees."
