M.G.L. c. 55 places certain requirements on political action committees which are not placed on "People's Committees." These include but are not necessarily limited to:

- (i) s. 5 requires that the name of a political action committee include the words "Political Action Committee" in said name.
(ii) s. 5A states that no candidate or individual holding elective public office shall establish, finance, maintain, control or serve as a principal officer of a political action committee.
(iii) s. 6A places limits on the aggregate amount of contributions certain candidates can accept from political action committees in a calendar year. When a political action committee makes a contribution to a candidate or a candidate's committee it must be made in the name of the political action committee.
