Mike Sullivan retires

OCPF Director Michael Sullivan retired on Dec. 27, but will remain with the agency in a consulting capacity to assist with implementing new [campaign finance legislation](#).

Sullivan was first appointed in 1994. Prior to working at OCPF, Mike was the Newburyport city clerk.

A commission consisting of the secretary of state, the chairs of the Democratic and Republican parties, and a law school dean appointed by the governor, will appoint a new director. Directors serve six-year terms.

DISSOLUTION

Unsuccessful candidates in your city or town can dissolve with your office to avoid having to file year-end reports in the future.

To file a dissolution report, a candidate can't have a balance or existing liabilities.

The dissolution report is the normal M102 form. The candidate or committee should check the dissolution box at the top of the form.
